Other Comments or Relevant Matters:

This Proposal seeks to amend maximum residue limits (MRLs) and extraneous residue limits (ERLs) for certain agricultural and veterinary chemicals in the Code. This is a routine process to maintain standards in the Code to allow for the sale of food in which chemical residues may legitimately occur.

This Proposal includes consideration of MRLs gazetted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) in April, May, June and August 2008. This includes consideration of incorporating MRLs in Standard 1.4.2 for new chemicals flubendiamide, profoxydim and pyroxsulam. The APVMA did not gazette any MRLs in July 2008.

This Proposal also includes consideration of varying MRLs for cypermethrin, fenhexamid, fenvalerate and glufosinate-ammonium and ERLs for dieldrin for a range of commodities in the Standard as a result of information provided by industry.
